Quicksand is a fascinating substance, make some of your own and experiment on a safe scale. Amaze your friends by demonstrating how it works.



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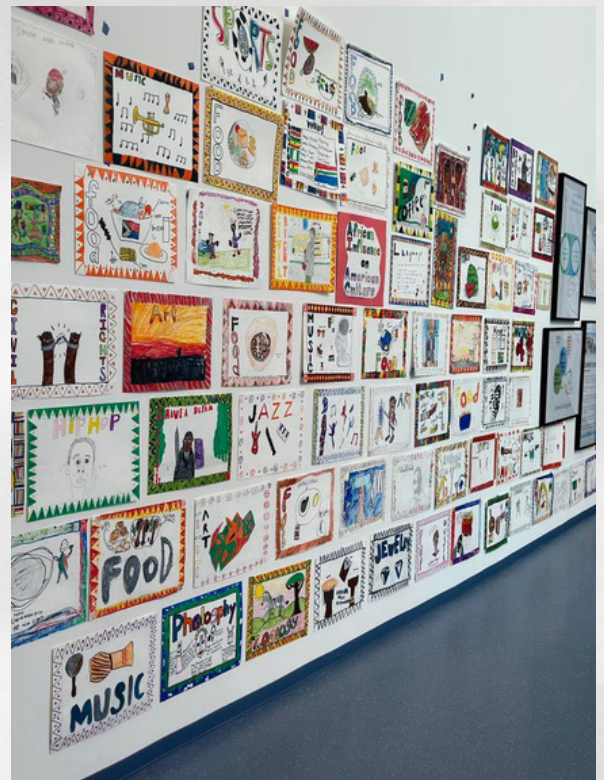
